

2021 CGA WOMEN'S PLAYER OF THE YEAR POLICIES

Player of the Year Honors – The Women's Player of the Year and Women's Senior Player of the Year will be selected by the Tournament Committee at the end of each season. Total points earned will help guide the Committee in their selection of a Player of the Year, but it will not necessarily be the player with the most points (i.e. the honor is for the Player of the Year rather than a points race). The Committee, in its sole discretion, may consider other factors when selecting a Player of the Year.

Player of the Year Eligibility – To be eligible for Player of the Year in any given points category, the player must be a CGA member in the current season and must have played in at least **two** events from this list of CGA Women's Championships and USGA Qualifiers hosted in Colorado: Women's Mashie, Women's Stroke Play, Women's Mid-Amateur Stroke Play, Women's Match Play, Women's Senior Stroke Play, Women's Brassie, Women's Dunham Chapman, U.S. Women's Senior Open, U.S. Women's Open, U.S. Women's Amateur, U.S. Senior Women's Amateur, U.S. Women's Mid-Amateur, U.S. Women's Four-Ball.

Points will be awarded only to those players in the championship flight of a CGA Women's Championship.

Colorado Cup – The Colorado Cup is a team event held in the fall of every odd numbered year. This competition is a Ryder Cup style event that includes teams from the CGA (Amateurs) and The Colorado PGA Section (Professionals). The CGA team selection process will be based primarily on cumulative points standings in the two years between the Cup matches. The Tournament Committee, in its sole discretion, may consider other factors when selecting the Colorado Cup team.

UPDATES FROM 2019

- 1) All CGA Individual Major Championship wins in each age division have been set to 450 points for the champion
- 2) The CGA Individual Major Championship wins point table have been adjusted to have more exponential weighting for wins and high finishes
- 3) For "age down" finishes in certain events, a 20% multiplier will be added to the points received in that player's age category. For instance, if a senior player earns points at the CGA Women's Stroke Play Championship, they would receive 40% more points within the Women's Senior Player of the Year list. If a senior player earns points at the CGA Women's Mid-Amateur Stroke Play Championship, they would receive 20% more points within the Women's Senior Player of the Year points list.
- 4) USGA Individual qualifiers have been adjusted in each age division to award 150 points for the medalist. The "age down" multiplier as described in #3 will also be applicable for USGA events.
- 5) USGA championships are set at 1,000 points for a win, and specific values for each round in match play.
- 6) Eligibility has changed. See above.
