 - Ensure daily caddie supplies (drinks, snacks, caddie equipment, safety supplies, etc.) are fulfilled.
- Build relationships with golfers and "caddie enthusiasts" to ensure caddie loop goals are met.
- Promote the SCLA to CommonGround patrons and the public.
- Communicate regularly with all involved parties.
- Attend caddie-related meetings.
