CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION



Format: 18 holes of stroke play.

Tees: White, USGA tee markers.

Distance Measuring Devices: Must measure distance only.

Qualifying positions: 5

Alternate Positions: 2

Ties: A sudden death playoff will decide a tie for qualifying positions and alternates. The playoff will be conducted immediately after the last score has been posted.

Replacement of Broken or Significantly Damaged Club: Local Rule G-9 is in effect.

Ball Played from Outside Relief Area When Taking Back-On-the-Line Relief: Local Rule E-12 is in effect.

Prohibiting Use of Audio and Video Devices: During a round, a player must not listen to or watch content of any nature on a personal audio or video device. Local Rule G-8 is in effect.

Immovable Obstructions Close to the Putting Green when Both the Ball and Obstructions are in General Area Cut to Fairway Height or Less: Local Rule F-5 is in effect.

LOCAL RULES

Out of Bounds: Defined the inside edge (course side) of the concrete curb on any public road or the parking lot.

Cart Paths: Cart paths or any artificially surfaced paths are *obstructions*.

Ground Under Repair: Denoted by white, enclosed lines. The mounds of material piled left of hole #11 is ground under repair. When ground under repair is immediately adjacent to an immovable obstruction, such an area is part of that obstruction.

Drop Zones: Labeled "USGA DZ". Available as an optional relief option under Rule 17.1 for a ball known or virtually certain to lie in the *penalty areas* on holes #6 and #12. Any other drop zones are not in use for this qualifier.
