CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION



Format: 72 holes of stroke play. A cut will be made to the low 40 players and ties after 36 holes.

Tees: White CGA tee markers.

Distance Measuring Devices: Permitted, provided they measure distance only.

Walking Only: Players may not use a motorized cart. Players may have a caddie, use a push cart or carry their own bag.

Ties: A tie for the championship will be decided by sudden death.

LOCAL RULES

Out of Bounds: Defined the inside edge (course side) of the concrete curb on any public road or the parking lot.

Cart Paths: Cart paths or any artificially surfaced paths are *obstructions*.

Gorund Under Repair: Denoted by white, enclosed lines.

Drop Zones: Labeled "DZ". Available as an optional relief option under Rule 17.1 for a ball known or virtually certain to lie in the *penalty areas* on holes #6 and #12.

Pace of Play: The 2020 CGA Group Pace of Play Policy will be enforced.

Penalty Area Lines: Faded lines near or in Red Penalty Areas have no status when more recently painted red lines are present.

Sprinkler Heads Near Putting Green: The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b by dropping a ball within one club length of the nearest point of complete relief and no closer to the hole if the ball and an immovable obstruction is:

- On the line of play, and is:
- Within two club-lengths of the putting green and in the general area cut to fairway height or less, and
- Within two club-lengths of the ball, which also must be in the general area cut to fairway height or less.
