Volunteer Uniform

- **Top:** Provided in volunteer packet.
 - Blue USGJ volunteer polo
 - Black USGJ jacket
- Hat: Provided in volunteer packet.
 - Black USGJ hat
- Bottoms: Not provided.
 - Please wear shorts/skirts/pants in a "neutral" tone.
 - i.e. khaki, tan, stone, bone, gray, white, etc.



What to Bring

- Water bottle
- Snacks
- Umbrella and rain gear (if performing outdoor tasks)
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray



USAFA Access

- Access to the golf course will mean access onto the base, and ALL volunteers will be REQUIRED to pass through the USAFA's normal entrance security checkpoint.
- The USAFA Gate Security Checkpoints will open at 5:30 a.m. each morning. Due to construction on the North Security Gate, the USAFA recommends that all volunteers proceed through the South Security Checkpoint.
- Volunteers will need to present state-issued identification. This includes anyone in the vehicle, not just the driver.
- Be prepared to be questioned and/or have vehicles searched—this is standard USAFA protocol.
- Please plan accordingly and account for time to pass through the Security Gate when determining your arrival to the course.

Please display in front window of vehicle at all times.

Parking

- Display your volunteer parking credential in the front window of your car at all time.
 - Included in your volunteer packet.
 - If not attending training in-person, you will receive your credential in Volunteer HQ at your first shift.
- Volunteer parking will only be allowed in the main golf course lot on Friday, July 14 and Thursday, July 20 through Saturday, July 23.
- Saturday, July 15 through Wednesday, July 19, volunteer parking is off site in Lot 5A.



Parking

- Once parked, shuttles will take you from Lot 5A to the back entrance of the clubhouse.
- At the end of your shift, the shuttle pick-up location will be near the back entrance of the clubhouse and the shuttle will return you to Lot 5A.
- Shuttles run from 5:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. daily.

Volunteer HQ

- Volunteer HQ is located in the pavilion.
- All volunteers must check in at Volunteer HQ prior to each shift, unless otherwise noted by your committee lead.
- This is where you will receive your instructions and materials and be directed to your shift location.
- This is also where you'll receive your meal ticket for your shift.

Shift Times

- The shift time listed on the schedule is the time you are expected to be at your position, ready to work.
- Please check in at Volunteer HQ 20-30 minutes ahead of your shift.
- 5:45AM shift start times:
- Do your best. We understand you have to get through the USAFA gate, park off site, shuttle to the clubhouse, and check-in at volunteer HQ.





Volunteer Meals

- Volunteers eat in Championship dining in the Blue/Silver room on the top level of the clubhouse. A volunteer meal voucher must be presented.
- Volunteers are allowed one buffet meal per shift worked that must be used on the day of the shift. This may require you to redeem your voucher before your shift begins. Allow plenty of time.
- Breakfast hours: 5:45AM 10:30AM
- Lunch hours: 11:00AM 3:30PM

Golf Course Evacuation

- In the event of inclement weather, the golf course will be evacuated.
- You will be notified of an evacuation and resumption by committee leads.
- Volunteers are asked to take shelter in their vehicles in Lot 5A.
- Volunteers are not able to evacuate to the clubhouse.
- Once play is resumed, flexibility of volunteers is greatly appreciated.
